Annaliza currently teaches the Leadership and Workplace Communication unit on the Graduate Certificate in Research Commercialisation on behalf of the JCIPP, Curtin University. The course is a collaboration of the Australian Technology Network. In April 2008 she completed curriculum materials for the Department of the Premier and Cabinet - *A Guide to Accountable and Ethical Decision Making*.
